

HASP Driver (Command Line) Installation |

Notice:

It is important to check Device Manager on the computer before attempting the steps mentioned below. If the security key is listed with any type of “bang”, i.e. **Red X**, **Yellow ?**, or **Yellow !**

1. Download the **HASP Driver (Command Line) Installation**

Click on Tech Support > Downloads
Scroll down and download the HASP Driver (Command Line) Installation
2. Extract the 3 files included in the **Hinstall.zip** to your desired folder.
For v2000, extract the files to **P:\Hasp**
For v8, extract the files to **C:\Program Files\Cyrious\SMS\Common\HASP**
Note: If prompted to overwrite the existing files, choose YES.
3. Open a Command Prompt window.
For Windows 98, ME: Click on Start > Run > type in Command
For Windows 2000/XP: Click on Start > Run > type in CMD
4. At the command prompt, type in the following to browse to the proper path.
For v2000, type in **CD P:\Hasp**
For v8, type in **CD C:\Program Files\Cyrious\Common\HASP**
5. Now that you are at the path where the Hinstall.exe is located, type:
hinstall -remove (this will remove any existing drivers)
6. After the uninstall of the drivers has completed, reinstall by typing:
hinstall -I (this will install the drivers for the Aladdin security key)
